The Mahwah Police Department & the Mahwah Municipal Alliance is proud to present the **5th Annual Youth Leadership Academy**.

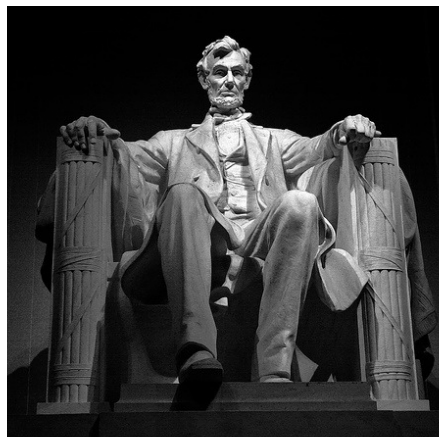
**The Leadership Academy is the only one of its kind offered in the state on New Jersey. It is a unique event, that develops interactive and communicative skills in a college environment**
